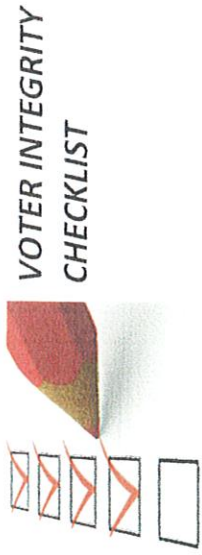


Reality Check for Your Legislator

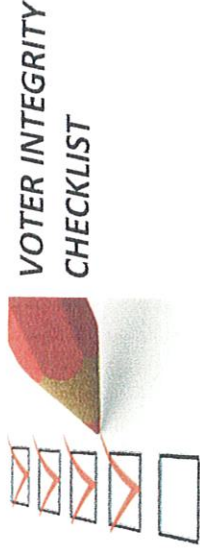


1. Is it moral?
